26/08/2024	2024/12	<p>The Chair of the Speed Committee, Mr Gernot Rittenschober, has requested ISC Bureau approval to make a modification to Sporting Code Section 5, Items: 5 3.2.8.1 (2) and 3.2.8.2 (2).</p> <p>At the last ISC Plenary Meeting, the new SP Mixed Team Event was introduced and approved. With the primary purpose of promoting female participation, the Event was included in the 2024 SP CRs and will take place at 5th FAI World Speed Skydiving Championships in October 2024 in Beaufort, North Carolina.</p> <p>In order to be able to claim and ratify new Mixed Team records it must be included in SC5 and not only in the SP competition Rules.</p> <p>The amendment is the inclusion of the words “or Mixed Team” in 3.2.8.1 (2) and 3.2.8.2 (2) as follows,</p> <p>3.2.8.1 Highest average speed <i>(2) The record performance of a team is the highest average speed of the team or mixed team achieved in any round in accordance with the current Competition Rules.</i></p> <p>3.2.8.2 Highest overall average speed <i>(2) The record performance of a team is the highest average speed of the team or mixed team for a completed competition program in accordance with the current Competition Rules.</i></p>	<p>The ISC Bureau has unanimously made the decision to approve this modification of SC5, which will be included in the 2025 Edition of the Sporting Code Section 5, with imminent effect so that Mixed Team records can be claimed and ratified in the next World Championships</p>
