Open is a remain from some years ago when we considered transgenders to take part. Nowadays there is an IOC regulation that cover this and I think this is also adopted by FAI. Put a reference to this into section 5 instead of Open in our rules.</p> <p>Delete the 2 participants team for female but keep the Ind. Female classification</p> <p>For teams mixed gender are already allowed, so only 1 team event.</p> <p>Regarding a classification where all competitors are ranked male, female and juniors so it can be possible for a junior or female to win the title of the whole competition. I don't know what will be the best name for it at the moment.</p> |
